RULES

Court and ball

- Half court with one basket. Out of bounds is the court perimeter and the half court line
- A size 6 ball is for the girls division. A size 7 ball is used for the boys division.

Teams & Qualifications

- Each team shall consist of 2 pre-registered players; 1 father or mother & 1 son or daughter. No substitutes allowed
- No restrictions for Fathers/Mothers (you can be as old as you want ☺)
- Sons/Daughters need to be in 8th grader through high school seniors
- If a player becomes injured during a game or needs to stop playing for more than a 5 minute period that team forfeits the game.

Game officials

- There aren't any. The offensive player will call their own fouls.
- If complaints arises regarding unreasonable fouling an event person may officiate a game.

Beginning of the game

- Both teams shall warm-up simultaneously prior to the game.
- A single free throw taken between the two teams shall determine which team gets the first possession.

Scoring

- Every successful shot inside the 3-point arc shall be awarded 1 point.
- Every successful shot behind the 3-point arc shall be awarded 2 points.
- No free throw shooting for fouls. Only stoppage of play and possession or repossession
- Every game will be played to 15. The first team to reach 15 (or more) wins
- The teams should call out the score after every bucket to avoid any confusion

Playing time/Winner of a game

- Each game will be allotted 30 minutes to complete. Teams are expected to move the pace of play along. Stalling could be grounds for disqualification.
- Each team is allowed 2 timeouts per game. Timeouts should not exceed 2 minutes.
- A team shall lose the game by forfeit if at the scheduled starting time the team is not present on the playing court with 2 pre-registered players ready to play.
- A team shall lose by forfeit if its players leave the court before the end of the game or a player is disqualified for bad behavior.

Fouls

- There is no limit or ejection for a particular amount of fouls however, players should not intentionally foul. A hard and obviously intentional foul could result in a player ejection by an event official and include team forfeiture.

How the game is played

Following each successful field goal or stoppage of play:

- A player from the scoring team will resume the game by calling "check" and passing the ball to the opposing team from behind the 3-point arc thus, allowing them to confirm they are ready to resume play. The ball is then passed back and the game is live from that point.
- There is no "pass-in" rule to resume / start play from one teammate to another.
- Once play is started or resume it continues until a team scores; a player is fouled or a timeout is called.
- If the offensive team rebounds the ball, it may continue to attempt to score without returning the ball behind the arc.
- If the defensive team rebounds or steals the ball, it must return the ball behind the arc (by passing or dribbling) before initiating a scoring chance.
- A jump ball should be called if the ball is held between two players for 3 seconds or more. In the event of a jump ball situation, the defensive team shall be awarded the ball.

Standings of teams

- There will be a boys division and a girls division.
- Teams will be eliminated from the tournament after two losses. Winning teams advance through a bracket structure. Losing teams drop into a loser bracket and will advance through it until another loss occurs.

Seeding

- To the best of our ability teams will be seeded so that initial matchups will be based on the common age of the son/daughter. Beyond that the seeding will be within two divisions and randomly made. There will be a boys division and a girls division.
